We heard updates from Chief Siewert that included the addition of a new firefighter, the future purchase of a grass rig, the new Christmas Lights have arrived, and the replacing of air packs. Council, Staff, and Chief discussed the possibility of moving the ice rink to the vacant lot on Brad Street.

The Park Bathroom remodeling is a step closer to reality as the Council approved bids for electrical, plumbing, and concrete work.
