Summer is nearing the end as Labor Day has come and gone. Mother Nature has given us several enjoyable days thus far in September and hopefully many more. School has started back up. So, please take your time in the morning and afternoon navigating the streets as the kiddos do not always look both ways.

The City Council met this past Tuesday. We heard updates on the Brad Street project and the park incidents from July 13th and 15th. The City Council approved Resolution 2024-06. The Resolution declared Zummerfest a community festival, allows Know It All's Bar and Grill to serve liquor off site in designated areas for the day. Zummerfest will be September 21st. Make sure to come out and support the Community Festival and check out the following Bands playing at Zummerfest: Up South 11am to 2pm, Judd Ave. 2:30 to 6:30pm, and Flying Train Wreck (Street Dance adjacent Know It All's Bar) 8pm to 12am.

City Staff presented the rough draft of the 2025 Budget. City Council and Staff will be holding a budget workshop on September 18th at 6 pm. Then at our second meeting of the month, on September 24th, we will set the preliminary budget. The preliminary budget will contain both wants and wishes on it. Once we set the preliminary budget the City Council and Staff will adjust the budget for a final levy to be set later in the year. If you have suggestions to be included in the budget, please let City Staff or Council know. Once the preliminary levy is set, we cannot increase it.

City Staff has done a great job keeping the page as up to date as possible too. If you have questions or a comment, please be respectful as we do not have the staff to be moderators of the page.


