I want to thank Deputy Mayor Tim Tracy for running the last Council meeting in my absence. I was out of town for work. Commissioner Fahey reported to the Council about the Carver County 2022 accomplishments and projects. Unfortunately, the Council could not decide on the variance request as the landowner has not completed several steps required before a variance can be considered. The Council did continue the Public Hearing to May 23rd at 6 pm. City Council Meeting to follow hearing.




County Road 50 Shoulder Widening Project Hamburg (W) to Co. Rd. 33
