

Greeting Hamburg

Hope everyone is doing well and staying safe. Especially as the smoke from the Canadian wildfires continue to impact our air quality.

At the City Council meeting on June 13th, the Council approved a variance for 480 Henrietta Ave. The variance was dealing with setbacks for the new home to be built on the site. The Fire Department selected, and Council approved, Steve Buckentin for Chief Three. The City has a vacant lot off Brad Street that we are looking for ideas on how to best use it. Unfortunately, the lot is limited in useability because of its size. All ideas are welcomed. Around the second week of July, watermain improvements will take place at the site of the Old Water Tower. There is likely to be a short disruption in the water supply.

Over the next few weeks, new street signs will be going up around town. Mostly, we are replacing faded and worn-out signs. At Bi-Centennial Park, the grills will be taken out. They are very rusty and unappealing to use.

Remember that City Wide Garage Sales are June 21-24. There is still a little time left to get your name on the map. Please call the City Office to let them know of your desire. Maps will be available next week too.

County Road 50 west of town has started construction. While there has been some activity on Country Road 50 to the east of town, the scheduled start time is July 9th. Please be aware of these projects as they may have the entire road closed for periods of time.

For those in community that have ATVs, dirt bikes, or other recreational vehicles, please be mindful of your neighbors. The ordinance allows everyone to use these vehicles on city streets to access trails and/or the dirt roads. So, please use self-control and common sense when operating these vehicles on the city streets.

You may have already seen him riding around town and mowing grass. Help me welcome Steve Frensko to the City Staff. Steve's primary focus will be mowing the parks and other city properties. Come out this Sunday to watch the Hawks take on the Brownton Bruins. Game starts at 4 pm. Rumor has it that the Hamburg Lions will be giving away Dilly Bars too.
