Hope everyone is doing well and getting ready for the dog days of Summer. The City Council is now entering into Budget season. September 19th we will have a Budget Workshop and then set the preliminary levy at the September 26th meeting. The preliminary levy is the most the final levy can be raised to for 2024. That said, we will put a lot of wish list items into the budget. After October 1st, the City Council and Staff will work diligently to reduce the preliminary levy. If you have any ideas on items to be considered please contact the City Council, City Staff, and/or myself.

At our last meeting, we were unable to hold the public hearing for the minor subdivision as the survey did not depict the correct property boundaries. We do hope to revisit this at our September 26th meeting so all parties can move forward with subdivision. MNSPECT Scott Qualle attended and discussed the building code in regards to the use of Diamond Piers. Zummerfest was deemed a City Festival. Council approved Firefighter Sam Newbloom.

Speaking of Zummerfest. It will be Saturday September 23rd starting at 11 am. Come on down to Bicentennial Park and enjoy the fun. There will be a kickball tournament, rib contest, mini rods, kids pedal pull, bounce house, craft show, classic cars, wine tasting, food, beer, bean bags and starting at 2pm No Time for Fame will be playing. This past Thursday morning, I attended the SW Corridor Transportation Coalition meeting. Updates on Highway 5, Glencoe roundabout, and Highway 212 projects. The stretch of Highway 212 from Cologne to Norwood Young America will be expanded to four lanes starting July 2024. There will be an overpass added to the intersection in Bongards. The project is expected to cost \$71,900,000 of which Carver County residents will be on the hook for \$5,630,000. The rest of the funds will be a combination of Federal, State, and MnDOT funds.
