Councilmember Chris Lund moved to approve the New Officers as noted for 2016. Seconded by Councilmember Richard Odoms. Motion unanimously carried. All Council Members were present.

- HFD Officer Wages for 2016-2017
 - Would like a \$200 raise for each officer in 2017
 - Mayor Malz requesting FD inquire with Green Isle, Plato, NYA, and Cologne for wage comparison.
- HFDRA Lucky 10 Gun Raffle (December 5, 2015)
 - Sold out of raffle tickets. Winners are posted in the truck bay.
- Toy Drive Breakfast (December 6, 2015)
 - All supplies were donated by a Fire Department member, therefore all proceeds went to the Fire Department. Raised \$848.00 as well as approximately \$200-\$300 in additional toys.
- Holiday Toy Drive (November 22nd to December 15th)
 - Mayor Malz inquired about the trailer: The trailer sold for \$3,500 and the Fire Department would like the proceeds to go towards two sets of new gear. Mayor Malz agreed with the request.

Resident Water Bill

- Merritt Pulkrabek is requesting the Councils assistance understanding a \$400.00 October Water Bill. Unsure why the bill is so high. There have been no leaks or water left on. November Bill came back down. Concerned that the meter is going bad.
 - Council decided to have Maintenance Worker Greg Schultz monitor the meter weekly for the next two months to see if there are any spikes. Council will make a decision based on the findings in a future council meeting.



Proposed tax concerns and questions

- Residents Mr. and Mrs. Rucks voiced they are concerned about the City of Hamburg's increase in taxes when Carver County and Central Schools went down.
- City Council: There have been some unforeseen expenses this past year which include Street Improvements, Legal Fees, Community Hall repairs, Community Center repairs. The Street project cost has been spread out over two years as well as the Hall repairs.

Old City Business

 - Avery and Jason are working on the parcel drawing right now. Used Sibley Survey out of Gaylord. Survey is done but documentation hasn't been received yet.

- County Road Maintenance Agreement (Carver County)
 - Waiting for answers on parking meter/sign, and curb to curb plowing questions.
- Service Memorial (Park)
 - Do we want to pursue the idea of a motion camera? Other's experiences with doing this is that they end up stolen. Council decided to wait and see what else happens.

Public Works & Utilities Department Report

- Councilmember Steve Trebesch inquiried about the open shelter shingling?
 - City Clerk Jeremy Gruenhagen reports that he hasn't heard anything for this year. It is in the budget for next year.

City Fee Schedule for 2016 – Ordinance Number 151

- 2016 City Fee Schedule Rates
 - Rate changes to the Community Center rental, mileage, water haul-out, and raising public hearing meeting fee from \$250 to \$300 and adding on-call pay.
- Water/Sewer/Storm Water Rates for 2016
 - Sewer Base Fund: stays the same at \$10.95
 - Metered Water Base: \$18.00 up to \$20.92
 - o Metered Water Per 1,000 gallons \$9.82
 - Water Capital Improvement: Stay the same at \$8.00



- o Storm Water Fee: Stays the same at \$10.95
- Metered Sanitary Sewer: Lowered from \$4.50 to \$4.15 per 1,000 gallons
- Overall increase of 16.2% for water, 10.75% decrease in sewer rate Monthly increase of \$7.26 per 5,000 gallons. ** Overall increase of 5.55% *
