- Force Main Relief Valve MH. The culvert at the end of Martha Street was plugged. After the culvert was jetted, there were complains that there was still a sewer smell. Greg found a small crack in the cement that is leaking from the Force Main MH. Greg will contact People Services to get the MH pumped out and see what is causing this issue.

Jeremy is going to do some final checking on the prices before a decision is made at next month's Council Meeting.
