Grinder Station Repairs

Mayor Malz called the Emergency Meeting to order at 8:33 p.m. Councilmember Chris Lund, Councilmember Bob Gregonis, Councilmember Richard Odoms, Councilmember Steve Trebesch, City Clerk Jeremy Gruenhagen, Maintenance Worker Greg Schultz, and Deputy Clerk Cherie Smith were in attendance.

Grinder Station for Lift Station on Jacob Street

- On July 31, 2014, a P.I. accident occurred on Jacob Street that took out the electrical panel, transfer switch, and meter for the Grinder Station. A generator is running a temporary service connection. Robb's Electric has set up a temporary panel and Xcel Energy will be out August 6, 2014 to hook up the electricity. After that is complete, the generator will not be needed.
- Councilmember Odoms received a quote from North Star Pump stating that the entire panel can be replaced with something that was similar to what was there and the replacement cost would not exceed \$16,000. This does not include the transfer switch and hook up which would be done by Robb's Electric.
- Councilmember Odoms moved to have Mike with North Star Pump order and install the new panel excluding the transfer switch and hook up, which will be done by Robb's Electric. The new panel will be replaced with a panel that is similar to the old panel and the price should not to exceed \$16,000, seconded by Councilmember Gregonis and motion unanimously carried. All Council members were present.

Councilmember Lund moved to adjourn the Emergency Meeting at 8:52 p.m., seconded by Councilmember Trebesch and motion unanimously carried. All Council members were present.
