
**RESOLUTION REESTABLISHING PRECINCT AND  
POLLING PLACE FOR THE CITY OF HAMBURG  
FOR 2018 ELECTION YEAR**

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes 204B.16, Subd. 1 was amended requiring the governing body of each municipality and of each county with precincts in unorganized territory must designate by ordinance or resolution a polling place for each election precinct by December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Hamburg City Council hereby establishes the boundaries of the voting precinct and polling place as follows:

- I. Boundaries of Voting Precinct: Entire City of Hamburg Corporate Limits.
- II. Precinct No. 1 - Hamburg City Hall at 181 Broadway Avenue.
